His own band "Kermesse" has played on radio; he currently plays with "Balkanatics", playing music of eastern Europe. David has run many education and community projects involving drama, improvisation and composition. He is examiner for the Royal Academy of Music, Royal College of Music and Trinity College of Music.
